Voted unanimously to accept March minutes.

Discussed the NHDES program for testing domestic wells. The program has been recently expanded making it more flexible and cheaper. We agreed to consider organizing a local well-testing event for Mason residents. Barbara will follow-up with NHDES to get more information.

Discussed a letter from N.H. Dept. of Natural and Cultural Resources regarding a grant from the Land and Water Conservation Fund (LCWF) for the railroad trail. Apparently they'll be inspecting the project as their rules require. The letter doesn't seem to require any action on our part. Bob L. will follow up to be sure.

Received a check from Dennis Graham for \$1,350.00 to cover April-June rent on the Old Ashby Rd. property. Money to be deposited in the Old Ashby Rd. fund.

Discussed the latest draft of the Conservation Plan from Liz. A draft suitable for public discussion will be forthcoming.

Barbara notes the next Drug Takeback Day is on the final Saturday of April.

Liz noted that NH DOT has installed some erosion control at the road-scrapings fill site along Rt. 31 near Walker Brook. Erosion control is good, but the pile is rather close to the brook so removing it would be better.

Liz reports that Craig Fifield has drafted a letter to LCHIP as needed to proceed with the changes to the Fifield Easement described in previous CC Minutes.
