Are you in favor of the adoption of **Amendment No. 1** as proposed by the Planning Board for the Town of Mason Planning (Zoning) Ordinance, as follows?

**Article 2:** Shall the Mason School District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling Two Million Nine Hundred Fifty Four Thousand Five Hundred Twenty Six Dollars (\$2,954,526), Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be Two Million Nine Hundred Fifty Seven Thousand One Hundred Thirty Six Dollars (\$2,957,136), which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Mason School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. **NOTE: This operating budget warrant article does not include appropriations contained in ANY other warrant articles.** The School Board recommends this warrant article. (Majority vote required.)
