From Chairman Moser: concerns regarding The Driving Range include new, different and expanded use of the property; sound spilling over, additional traffic. Mason's zoning ordinance state that no commercial uses are allowed unless through special exceptions from the Zoning Board. Any new use requires a site plan review; reasonable hours and ground rules need to be established.

Everyone's expectations should be set at the outset and neighbors should be heard through the planning process.

The Driving Range went through the site plan review process in 1993, after which the Planning Board waived recording of site plan.

Initial special exceptions include: Hours of 7:00 AM to 10:00 PM; Restaurant and golf accepted; 2010 Special Exception from Zoning Board of Adjustment for additional seating; beer and wine to be allowed in patio area; kitchen hours designated.

Peter Bennett and Nicole Ruggerio: An attempt has been made to have people park at A-1 Services on Reed Road and to walk down to concerts.

Selectman O'Grady reported that parking is a major issue; additionally concerts create a great deal of traffic on Route 124.

Peter Bennett reported that concerts are on Thursday and Saturdays evenings and that sound may be an issue. Select Person Lavoie

reported that there have been more noise complaints regarding Thursday nights, rather than Saturday night.

Chairman Moser said that permission for liquor on patio area is granted at the local level, not through the NH Liquor Commission.
